CALL TO ORDER

1. WRITTEN DETERMINATION

I, Burton Hohman, as the Chair of the Vineyard City Bicycle Advisory Commission, do hereby find and declare as follows:

- Due to the Emergency conditions which currently exist in the State of Utah, and specifically in Utah County and Vineyard City as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic and the recent surge in COVID-19 infections across the state and in Utah County, the holding of public meetings with an anchor location as defined in the *Utah Open and Public Meetings Act*, presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location; and

- The risk to those who may be present at an anchor location can be substantially mitigated by holding public meetings of the Bicycle Advisory Commission pursuant to electronic means that allow for public participation via virtual means; and
- The City has the means and ability to allow virtual participation in the public meetings in accordance with the *Utah Open and Public Meetings Act*;

NOW THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING,

For thirty days from the date of this Order, meetings of the Vineyard City Bicycle Advisory Commission shall be conducted by virtual means without an anchor location.

2. OPEN SESSION

“Open Session” is defined as time set aside for citizens to express their views for items not on the agenda. Each speaker is limited to three (3) minutes. Because of the need for proper public notice, immediate action cannot be taken in the Planning Commission Meeting. If action is necessary, the item will be listed on a following agenda. However, the Planning Commission may elect to discuss the item if it is an immediate matter of concern.
