| Type of Vehicle | Description | Restrictions | Driver's License Required | Motorcycle Endorsement |

|  Motorcycle | A motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel with not more than three wheels in contact with the ground | 0= 90 cc or less 2 = 249 cc or less 3 = 649 cc or less | ✔ | ✔ |
|  Moped | A motor-drive cycle which is not capable of propelling the cycle at a speed in excess of 30 MPH on level ground | No public property, highway, path, or sidewalk, unless mini-motorcycle is registered for highway use and the operator is licensed to operate a motorcycle | ✔ | ✔ |
|  Motorized Bike | A moped not capable of propelling the device at a speed of more than 20 MPH on level ground | | ✔ | ✘ |
|  Mini-Motorcycle/Pocket Bike | A motor-driven cycle that has a seat or saddle that is less than 24 inches from the ground | No public property, highway, path, or sidewalk, unless mini-motorcycle is registered for highway use and the operator is licensed to operate a motorcycle | ✔ | ✔ |
|  Motor Assisted Scooter | A motor assisted scooter has at least two wheels in contact with the ground and have a deck designed for a person to stand on while operating the device | No public parking structure, public property prohibiting skateboards, highway of four or more lanes, roadway with a speed limit greater than 25 mph, etc. | 16+ = ✘ Under 15 = parent or guardian supervision Under 8 = Not permitted | ✘ |

|  <p>Utility Type Vehicle</p> | <p>Any recreation vehicle designed for and capable of travel over unimproved terrain on four+ tires</p> | <p>Must operate on a street designated for street-legal ATV use. |  <p>Street-Legal ATV</p> | <p>Street-legal ATV is an all-terrain type 1 vehicle that is modified to meet the requirements of Utah Traffic Code 41-6a-1509 to operate on a street or highway</p> | <p>Must operate on a street designated for street-legal ATV use. May not exceed the lesser of 1.) the posted speed limit, 2.) 45mph Must comply with traffic rules, insurance, and safety inspections</p> |  |  |
|  <p>Electric Personal Assistive Mobility Device</p> | <p>Self-balancing device with a maximum speed capacity of 12.5 MPH</p> | |  |  |
